Recordings by the famous Spanish Composer Enrique Granados

Enrique Granados came to the United States to hear the World Premier of his Opera 'Goyescas' at the Metropolitan Opera House, New York on January 28, 1916. While in New York he interpreted and recorded these pieces for the Duo-Art. These recordings represent musical Impressionism at its' best. Tragically Granados died on his return voyage to his home in Spain when the steamship he was on was torpedoed and sunk by a German submarine on March 24, 1916. These lovely & sensitive selections are some of the best ever recorded.
