There are approximately 102 wooden pipes and 14 reed pipes.

Included are 4 pinned barrels, one not in a case, one in a case and two in a case.

The base has dimensions of 48 $\frac{3}{4}$ in. high, 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. deep and 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. wide The other frame is 47 in. high by 33 in. wide and 19 in. deep.

The base with wheels is 33 in. by $19 \frac{1}{2}$ in.
