MEMORANDUM


# A Few Hints on the Care of the MASTERTOUCHE MUSIC ROLL



1. *Before placing the roll in position for playing, see that the music roll is loosely wound on spool, then hold in the hand with slotted end down. Let the roll drop lightly two or three times against a hard surface, thus throwing the entire music sheet against the right flange of the spool. Then slightly tighten the roll, which is now ready to play.*
2. *Be sure before commencing to play the roll that the initial note is in its correct position over the tracker-bar. This will obviate the use of the transposer during playing.*
3. *DON'T suddenly RE-ROLL in the midst of playing; stop first, and then RE-ROLL.*
4. *When RE-ROLLING maintain a steady pressure on the pedals, and hold the lever to the RE-ROLL position.*
5. *When you have removed the roll, preparatory to replacing it in its box, DON'T wind the roll with your hands to such an extent that it begins to "shriek" under protest; a FEW turns will suffice, as the cord and stud attachment on the MASTERTOUCHE ROLL will prevent any unwinding movement taking place when not in use.*
